

Formulary Information

A formulary is a list of covered medications. Specific plans have unique formularies, so make sure to find the formulary that applies to you.

Formularies are updated on the website every three months (except for Medicare Part D formularies, which are updated monthly). The Formulary Changes document is updated monthly. The Formulary Changes document notifies members of changes to the formularies that occur between formulary updates.

Pharmaceutical management procedures are processes that help manage the drug formulary. In order to provide the most cost-effective therapy options, restrictions may be applied to certain medications on the formulary. The SWHP formularies contain a description of pharmaceutical management procedures, including but not limited to:

- Prior authorization (PA)
- Quantity limits (QL)
- Step therapy (ST)
- Therapeutic interchange, and
- Generic substitution

If a medication has restrictions in place, those are listed on the formulary. The formularies also contain information regarding how to submit an exception request.
