Send MCO Healthy Texas Women Materials by July 23

Background:

As part of implementation of Senate Bill 750, 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, requirement to improve continuity of care for women transitioning from Medicaid to Healthy Texas Women (HTW), HHSC is reviewing how the STAR MCOs are currently educating members about HTW.

Key Details:

As stated in the Uniform Managed Care Contract (UMCC) 8.2.2.2 and 8.2.10 MCOs must have procedures in place to educate providers and the following members about family planning programs, including the HTW Program:

- Pregnant women who will lose eligibility after delivery; and
- Young pregnant adults who will have aged out of Children's Medicaid by the time of delivery.
