- Most members in the following counties will automatically transition to Medicare Advantage plans called SeniorCare Advantage and will continue to have coverage through Scott and White Health Plan:



Members with prescription drug coverage through a carrier other than Scott and White Health Plan may not be automatically enrolled. Call Customer Service at 866-334-3141 (TTY: 711) for more information.

- If members live in other counties, they will receive information on or before
 October 1 on how to find other Medicare plans for 2019. There are no Medicare
 products available with Scott and White Health Plan other than in the counties
 listed above.
